






120 Years of Amps

Celebrating 120 years of Amps

We've been proud to trade as a family business for 120 years this year, so read on to learn more about us and our history.

We did a little research into the Amps name and family history. It is thought that our name may have originated from Ampthill in Bedfordshire. Fantastically, we traced our direct line back to approximately 1660 - the time of Oliver Cromwell!

John Amps opened the business in July 1901, aged 36. Back then it was described as a family grocers, provision merchants, wines and spirits trader and tallow chandlers. John saw the opportunity for enterprise in the bustling market town of Oundle and purchased the business for the total cost of £500!

Our shop at that time would have looked similar outside as it does today, where it is currently occupied by Tesco. The business had one distinctive feature, which was its telephone number – number '2' as we had the second phone in Oundle! Deliveries were originally made by horse and cart, but our delivery methods have changed a little over the years.

John died in 1928, leaving youngest son Percy to run the business, who took it from strength to strength.





Percy's son, Michael, started working in the business when he left school. One of the changes he introduced was a mobile shop to cover the surrounding villages. In 1972 major refurbishments took place and the shop was extended backwards to join up with the old warehouse, creating a supermarket with offices to the rear and a storage area under the new shop floor. Our supermarket was highly rated by the local people, providing a wide range of highclass products.

The 1980s saw a lot of changes to the business. Philip, one of Michael's sons, was determined that the family business would continue its reputation of being the very best in the area. Michael suggested that Philip should take a keener interest in wines because he felt that wine was going to become more popular in future years... how right he was! Philip's interest in wine not only became important in work but also a serious hobby. The wine section soon outgrew the space available in the supermarket, leading Philip to convince his father to separate this section from the main grocery shop. A derelict building was purchased and converted for this purpose behind 6 Market Place. These premises were opened on 22nd April 1993 and is where we trade from in the Market Place today!



Michael and Philip decided to close the grocery business later that year, following the development of two large supermarkets in Oundle. They devoted all their energies to the wine business, with it flourishing into the major independent wine business we are today, with our Oundle shops, website and wholesale side offering the finest wines from the best independent winemakers.



Sadly, Michael died in 2015 so never saw the opening of our second sister shop at Oundle Wharf in 2016. The shop stocks the same range of wines and offers the friendly and knowledgeable service we are known for, but in a more contemporary setting.

We import most of our range direct from the vineyards and producers we love. We taste all of our wines, only stocking what we believe to be the very best in terms of quality, style and value. Who knows what will happen in the next 120 years?

Chateau de Plaisance

Meet Vanessa Cherruau.

Vanessa makes wine in a particularly special place in the Loire Valley. She has a vision, she's something of a live-wire and in the very best traditions of her forebears, she's in the process of leading a revolution!

Vanessa has vineyards in two of the Loire's most important appellations, the Grand Cru Quarts de Chaume and the neighbouring Premier Cru Chaume. Although tiny, these two appellations are proper, doff your cap, tug your forelock, don't speak until you're spoken to, vinous aristocracy. Internationally recognised nobility. The big league. Vanessa has only recently taken over at Chateau de Plaisance but she's making waves in the region straight away. We've not checked her personal politics but what she does with these upper class grapes is definitely a bit radical socialist. She declassifies them right the way down to everyday, common or garden Anjou Blanc status... that'll teach them!

Anjou Blanc 2019, France



This is one of those wines where we look you in the eye and just say, 'Trust us'. You're definitely not going to be unhappy with this particular purchase. It's beautifully precise for such a richly textured wine. There's peach, a touch of honey, a sense of late summer meadow, the characteristic waxy feel of Chenin Blanc and there's a sense of gentle movement and energy in the wine as well... it's all held together and focused with a little crackle of fresh lemony acidity and finishes long, fine and dry... and its beautifully presented to boot!

Don't over-think this one. it's been made to be approachable, versatile and easy to enjoy, with or without food.





Quarts de Chaume and Chaume you see, are appellations exclusively for sweet wines and Vanessa (mainly) wants to make dry wines and very passionately believes that her unique terroirs offer the potential to make some of the Loire's very finest dry wines at that. We've tasted all of the wines she has released so far and we're not going to argue. This is one of the most exciting estates we've found, not just in the Loire, but in France as a whole for quite some time!

The technical detail... the vines (100% Chenin Blanc) are an average of 20 years old, grown mainly on Schist soils which is where the 'power' comes from... wild yeast fermentation... ageing in tank (no wood) for 11 months... partial malolactic. The estate is 100% organic and 100% biodynamic.

We're looking forward to welcoming Vanessa either in person or via Zoom in the not too distant future... in the meantime grab a few bottles of this rather special Anjou Blanc!




Moonshine
