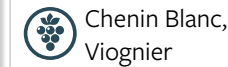

When it comes to English wine there's a lot to shout about, so we've rounded up our current favourites!

Lyme Bay, Devon: At this winery in picturesque Devon, they like to do things a little differently. Since 2015 they've been working with some of the best English winegrowers to craft award winning still and sparkling wines. Being one of a few wineries that work with growers nationwide, they have access to the best fruit grown on different soils or in different microclimates throughout the country, rather than just relying on what is grown in their own vineyards.

Henners, East Sussex: A 7 acre vineyard based just 4 miles from the sea in Herstmonceux, East Sussex. It was created in 2007 by ex-Formula One engineer, Lawrence Warr, who named the winery in honour of his French ancestor, Henners Dubois. The vines thrive in an idyllic microclimate created by the vineyard's proximity to the sea, low altitude and steep, sunny, south facing slopes. All the wines are hand-crafted from start to finish, with the emphasis very much on quality rather than quantity, resulting in an award winning range of wines.

This has the classic fresh, floral, elderflower note we have come to know of the Bacchus grape... arguably England's signature grape variety and answer to Sauvignon Blanc!
