Our Wines of the Year



Margaret River is a total wine paradise, ideal for growing world-class Chardonnay, which is exactly what we have here, made by the region's founding wine estate. It's not like those Aussie Chardonnays from the past, this is lighter, delicate even, with only a few months spent in oak barrels allowing the fruit flavours to steal the limelight. It's an excellent alternative to good quality white Burgundy from France! You'll be drawn into the glass by aromas of zesty grapefruit, 'dribble down your chin kind of ripe' peaches, green apple and vanilla. Flavour-wise, it's creamy and rich with an abundance of texture, grapefruit and lemon curd flavours, just a stroke of toasty oak and sweet spice before a refreshing finish, which hip, Vouvray! makes you crave another glass.

A winner with Christmas turkey and all the trimmings.



The Pinon family have been producing striking wines since 1786... they seem to have a way with Chenin Blanc that coaxes out the voluptuous and decadent side of the variety. Julien, the 8th generation of the family to run the estate, is simply one of the best winemakers in the Loire region. This is quite unique... a white wine composed of several different vintages, much like they do in Spain with Sherry. The result? Super rich, super lovely, super sensual... like falling face first into a huge bowl of Chenin jelly! There is a touch of sweetness but it's not what you'd call a sweet wine, it's just ultra ripe with honeyed tarte tatin and lush ripe stone fruit flavours and shimmering acidity at the finish for freshness. An absolute 'cracker' that will catch your eye... hip,

A seriously stunning starter pairing with pâté on Christmas Day or indulge with a cheeseboard.

These are the wines that we feel deserve spotlighting, the Amps team's unanimous favourite wines of the year...here's to the glass of 2023!



When Aussie Shiraz is properly made it's not just good, it's REALLY good... cue this wine! The team would all happily pay £25 a pop for this because it really over delivers for the money... an absolute humdinger from legendary vineyards. Robust and not short of personality; bursting with aromas of ripe blackberries, spices, bramble and cherries which flow into a joyful pool of forest fruit flavours, jammy cherries and salted chocolate then finally, a creamy and silky finish. All that flavour is well supported by good structure and plush vanilla oak tannins. Although gorgeous now, it will age gracefully over the next 5 or so years...if you can stop yourself from drinking it now!

Looking for something tall, dark and handsome? We've got just the bottle here! Made by a family estate with a winemaking history spanning three generations, from fruit grown on the oldest vines (40-70 years old) in their vineyards, then left to mellow in large oak barrels for a year. The team were bowled over by its understated elegance. It isn't the typical powerful and oaky style that you might associate with red wines from this region. Whilst there's serious concentration of black fruit and cherry flavours, there's also the estate's signature freshness running throughout. It's a masterclass in winemaking brilliance. We love it!

Incredibly versatile - pairs with red and white meats - and perfect with tapas.

Eat, Drink & Be Merry

STARTER

We had to include this wine as it's THE perfect all-rounder to pair with any kind of starter on Christmas Day. Retro prawn cocktail? Check. Shop-bought canapés? Check. Indulgent pâté? Check.

Full-bodied and well balanced, with a seductive finish.



Quinta do Piloto have a secret ingredient that makes this wine not only incredibly complex and delicious, but also literally unique! The family winery has a tiny cellar area tucked-away in a corner containing a handful of 100 litre chestnut barrels, in which they age this special wine. As the barrels are very old they add almost no wood influence to the wine but they contain what is called 'mother' liqueur. This is a tiny proportion of wine and lees that is never removed and contributes to every wine that is aged in the barrels lees (similar to a solera system for making sherry) and adds concentration and complexity to the wine. Rich and decadent with a textural mouthful of incredibly concentrated dried and candied fruits and remarkable freshness... a sheer delight with Christmas pud!
