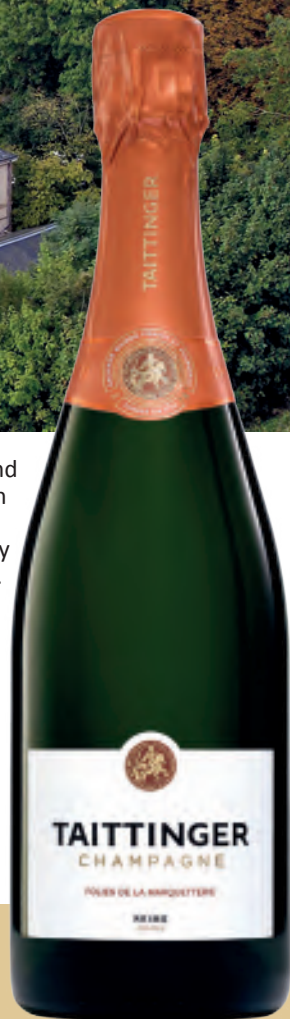

Think you know Riesling? Drink Again!

Due to his uncompromising passion and skills, Sven Nieger has become something of a cult winemaker and has earned strong accolades from critics such as Jancis Robinson, Robert Parker and James Suckling.

Sven Nieger is a maverick: his ambition is for his wines to reflect his embrace of organic viticulture and recognition of the benefits of environmental bio-diversity and minimal intervention.

Sven's main wine (Underdog) and his top wine (Unbestechlich) both have great structure, minerality and floral notes with a distinctive creamy texture and good acidity.

Enjoy these "new wave" Rieslings from Baden with a fish starter on Christmas Day, a charcuterie board or just savour on their own.

'Unbestechlich' is German for 'Incorruptible', so named because this is a wine made with no compromises. Although dry this has an unwavering concentration of fruit and minerality which imparts so much texture, the finish is like biting into a fresh green apple... mouthwatering is the word!

We really didn't need to add another Beaujolais to our collection, but Philip Amps attended a tasting recently and the winemaker insisted that he taste it... Philip loved it "delicious and fruity" so got a sample for the team to taste and we agreed, so although we didn't need it, did we want it? Absolutely!

The top wines of Beaujolais come from "the crus": the ten villages which produce the best quality wines in the region, and whose names appear on the label as individual appellations. Saint-Amour, is one of the smallest and most northerly of these, located just to the south of Burgundy, producing some of the lightest wines in the region.

This charmingly-named Cru is a wine to share with your loved ones on Christmas Day because it will be perfect with roast turkey and all the trimmings. It will seduce you with its juicy wild strawberry, cherry and blueberry fruit, spice and liquorice notes, all with the elegance that makes its name.

Looking for a special wine to celebrate Christmas or shopping for someone who knows a thing or two about wine? Here are some exceptional quality wines that will be remembered and discussed long after the last glass is empty.

Louis Jadot Le Clou d'Orge Ladoix Blanc 2022

Burgundy, France | 13.5%
Chardonnay

Ladoix is a tiny appellation sandwiched between two of the best-known village areas of Burgundy, the Grand Cru Hill of Corton and Nuits St Georges. The proximity of these two famous villages gives you an indication of the quality of Ladoix. This wine oozes class, made from hand-picked fruit, followed by ageing in the best French oak barrels. Rich and ripe nose of peach and apricot, with hints of vanilla, lovely mouth filling texture, and a long mineral finish. A great wine has layers of flavour with each sip showing you more... this wine does just that!

Chateau de Rochemorin Pessac Leognan 2016

Bordeaux, France | 13%
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot
